

## Arrhythmia Symposium 2010

I would like to invite you to the Scottish Arrhythmia Groups' annual symposium at West Park Conference Centre, Dundee, on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2010.

This is the second annual arrhythmia symposium to be held in Dundee, providing expert insights in a wide area of arrhythmia topics for healthcare professionals with an interest in the management of patients with arrhythmias.

The theme this year is 'New Perspectives in Cardiac Arrhythmia Management' focussing on recent developments in pharmacotherapy, electrophysiologic intervention and devices, and their application to clinical management in 2010 and beyond. In addition to known leaders in arrhythmia and electrophysiology in Scotland, this year's speakers also include eminent international experts, Professor Paul Dorian, Professor John Camm and Dr Elijah Behr. The expert faculty and the format of this year's symposium, with a debate and workshops, ensure it to be a stimulating and informative meeting.

Sudden arrhythmic death (SADS) in young people due to inherited cardiac conditions is universally recognised as an important area, yet prevention of SADS in this era remains a challenge. A session of the meeting will focus on this important area, and the contributions from specialists in genetics, forensic pathology, cardiology, nurses, primary care and importantly a patient's own experience will offer a unique opportunity to explore and discuss practices and strategies that could prevent these tragic events.

The dateline for registration is the 20<sup>th</sup> February, and 6 CPD points are applied for. Please see the attached meeting invitation.
